- 2. ANN JENNINGS was born at Sandwich 17 October 1670, daughter of John¹ and Ruhama (Turner) Jennings.⁵ She married, about 1693, Joseph³ Holway, born about 1668 and died testate at Sandwich in 1732. He was a son of Joseph² (Joseph¹) and Mary (Hull) (Capt. Tristram², Rev. Joseph¹ Hull) Holway (also spelled Holley/Holloway). The will of Joseph³ Holway of Sandwich, yeoman, dated 4 Oct. and proved 27 Dec. 1732, gives: to my loving wife Ann the improvement of all real and personal estate, so long as she remains my widow. To son Joseph £8; to son Gideon (whom he made executor), meadows in Barnstable and £150, also housing and other land in Sandwich and Barnstable; to four daughters Reliance, Mary, Anne, and Meribah [surnames not given], £60 each. The inventory dated 15 November 1732 shows real estate appraised at £2000.8

Children of Joseph and Ann (Jennings) Holway:9

- Joseph Holway, b. 6 Nov. 1694; m. Hannah Soule of Dartmouth [b. 1 June 1694, dau. of William³ Soule (George², George¹, Mayflower passenger)]; both living 8 May 1725 when among heirs to her father's estate.¹⁰
- 15 ii. Reliance Holway, b. 16 Feb. 1696; living and probably married by 1732 when she was given same bequest as her married sisters.*
- 16 iii. Mary Holway, b. 18 June 1699; d., perhaps in the South; m. 25 Oct. 1721 Benjamin Soule (brother of Hannah above); five children.
- iv. Anne Holway, b. 1 June 1702; m. 3 Oct. 1726 John³ Jennings (her cousin, see no. 22 below).
- v. Gideon Holway, b. 5 Oct. 1704; m. 26 May 1732 Experience Wing [b. 8 Mch. 1707/8, dau. of Jashub³ (Daniel², John¹) and Anna (Hoxie) Wing]¹¹; seven children.
- vi. Meribah Holway, b. ca. 1706 (not recorded); m. 20 Sept. 1733¹¹ John⁴ Soule [b. 20 Nov. 1707; d. testate Dartmouth ca. 1771]; as Meribah Soule, widow of John, she surrendered her dower rights by deed 26 June 1772.¹¹
- 4. ISAAC² JENNINGS was born at Sandwich 3 July 1677, a son of John and Ruhama (Turner) Jennings.⁵ He died testate at Pembroke, Plymouth County, between 12 February 1760 and 6 June 1761. He married, first, by Shearjashub Bourne, J.P., 10 July 1700, Rose Goodspeed,¹² born 20 February 1680 and died 21 December 1721, daughter of John² (Roger¹) and Experience (Holway) Goodspeed (Joseph¹ Holway). Isaac married, secondly, 31 October 1723, Hannah Nye, born 19 June 1685 and died between 2 June 1757 and 12 February 1760, daughter of John² (Benjamin¹) and Esther (Shedd) Nye of Sandwich.¹³
